If there is any particular breed/variety or topic that any one would like to have discussed at the conclusion of a meeting, just let us know and we will do our best to provide.


We donated several medallions to other clubs in the state for Best Rare Breed/Variety – these are very much Appreciated and promote both our club and rare poultry in Tasmania.


MAJOR PRIZE WINNERS







Even the poultry judges were impressed by the turnout of rare birds at Tasmania's rare breeds poultry show over the weekend.



The Reverend James Bishop from Colac says even after a lifetime of poultry breeding, he came across some varieties for the first time.





